

## Borrowing Works from the London Pro Musica Choir Score Library

London Pro Musica Choir's extensive score collection of over 550 titles is available for loan to other choirs for rehearsal and performances. Our complete inventory is listed in **title** and **composer** lists posted to our website. These are updated periodically as we grow our collection with new repertoire.

The lists also include information such as voicing and publisher to give additional detail as well as the number of copies we have available for loan. Scroll the list or use your browser *Find* option to narrow your search.

You can request scores a variety of ways. A **Loan Request Form** is available via the choir website. Complete the form with as much detail as possible and attach it to an email to us. Alternatively, just contact us at **library@londonpromusica.ca** with a list of the titles you require and we'll look after the rest.

Along with the titles you wish to borrow, we require your organization name and address as well as complete contact information, name, email and phone/text number for the person requesting material on behalf of your choir. Let us know the date of your performance using the material so we can arrive at an appropriate due date for returning scores, understanding that collecting material back after a concert may take a little time. Remember to indicate the number of copies you require for your choristers.

After verifying that we own the the work and confirming that it has not been programmed into our concert season, we'll contact you to arrange delivery and pull the copies you've requested from our collection. There is no limit on the number of titles you can borrow, however as a general rule only repertoire for a single performance should be included in one request form.

There may be gaps in the sequence where we are missing specific numbers of a particular title. We will note this on the summary sheet included with the scores in order to provide an accurate record of all the material you receive. You will be responsible for any additional missing scores or damaged content.

We'll package the scores and include the summary of your loan containing all the necessary information, significant dates and our contact details should you need to get in touch with us.

We have a few conditions on the use of our scores in order to protect and preserve the material. We ask that your choristers notate scores using pencil only and your markings are removed using a soft white eraser before returning to us. We also request that scores are not 3-hole punched.

There are no borrowing fees for this service. Shipping charges to you and back to us, if required, will be negotiated on a case by case basis.

We look forward to sharing our collection with your choir.
